

## MOTO TRIP TO 3 ASIAN COUNTRIES

**Itinerary:** KGZ, UZB, KZ

**Trip season:** June-August

**Duration:** 20 days

**Group size:** 4-10 pax

**Tour type:** driving on motorbikes

Supporting car with driver, guide and mechanic

**Accommodation:** hotels, guest houses, home stays

### DETAILED PROGRAM:

#### Day 1. Arrival to Bishkek

Manas international airport. Transfer to hotel. Resting time. Lunch.

Walking in the city. Dinner.

#### Day 2. Burana Tower in Tokmok

After breakfast group transfer by bus to Tokmok city, visiting the Historical sight of X-XI cc. –

Burana Tower (Minaret). One of the first buildings of such type in Central Asia. It is located about 80 km east of the Bishkek. The tower, along with grave markers, some earthworks and the remnants of a castle and three mausoleums, is all that remains of the ancient city of Balasagun, which was established by the Karakhanids at the end of the 9th century. Lunch.

Back to Bishkek. Dinner at hotel.



#### Day 3. Bishkek – Toktogul (275 km)

After breakfast way to Toktogul through Bishkek-Osh highway the most popular road among local people reaching the south part of Kyrgyzstan. The road is picturesque - it goes first along the river Kara-Balta with the rise of the pass Too-Ashu 3,200 meters, then descended to Suusamyr valley, located at an altitude of about 2000 meters. In the gorge of the river can be reached Chychkan Gorge in Toktogul valley, where the Toktogul reservoir.

Overnight in guest house. Resting time and walking around Naryn river. flowing among the cliffs of the Tien Shan mountain range.

**Day 4. Toktogul – Osh (340 km)****Day 5. Osh.**

After breakfast transferring to Osh the second largest city in Kyrgyzstan, located in the Fergana Valley in the south of the country and often referred to as the "capital of the south". It is the oldest city in the country (estimated to be more than 3000 years old). Walking around the city.

Accommodation in a hotel.

**Day 6. Osh – Fergana**

After breakfast, way to the youngest cities in Uzbekistan Fergana. This place located in the south of the Fergana Valley. Fergana located at an altitude of 580 meters above sea level and is one of the important centers for oil production. In Fergana there are no ancient architectural and historical monuments, but its suburbs are famous for their unique beautiful places. The best Uzbek crafts people are producing famous handicrafts also here. Accommodation and dinner in a hotel.

**Day 7. Fergana – Samarkand****Day 8. Samarkand**

Driving to Samarkand the legendary capital of the empire of Tamerlane. There are many historical places such as Registan Square and three madrassahs (religious study centers) surrounding the square: Ulughbek Madrassah (XV c), Sher-Dor Madrassah (XVII c), and Tillya-Kari Madrassah (XVII c) – covered with gold. Visit to Gur Emir Mausoleum – tomb of Tamerlane, Shakh-i Zinda Necropolis – ensemble including mausoleums and other ritual buildings of IX-XIV and XIX CC, Ulughbek Observatory, built in XV century by Timurid ruler and astronomer, Bibi Khanym Mosque – built by Amir Timur (Tamerlane) in XV century and Siyab Bazaar.

Dinner and overnight in a hotel.

### **Day 9. Samarkand – Bukhara**

Breakfast at the hotel. Driving to Bukhara – one of the most important stops on the Silk Road. You can visit to the Ark Fortress (I-XX CC), Bolo Hauz Mosque (XVIII C), Magoki Attori Mosque (XII C).

Continue sightseeing: Poi-Kalyan complex with Kalyan Minaret (XII C) through orient bazaars with three trade domes of Toki Zargaron (XV C), Toki Sarrafon (XVI C), Toki Telpak Furushon (XVI C), Ulugbek Madrassah (XV C), Abdulazizkhan Madrassah (XVII C), Lyabi Hauz complex (XVI -XVII CC), surrounded by ancient mulberry trees, restaurants and cafes. Overnight in a hotel.



### **Day 10. Bukhara – Khiva**

#### **Day 11. Khiva**

Breakfast. Walking around the city. Khiva has several historical names include Khorasam, Khoresm, Khwarezm, Khwarizm, Khwarazm, Chorezm. According to archaeological data, the city was established in the beginning of the Christian era. Place for the visit walled inner town Ichan Kala (UNESCO WHS, XIV-XX CC) with Muhamad Amin Khan Madrassah, Kalta Minor Minaret, Kunya Ark, Muhamad Rahim Khan Madrassah, Juma Mosque and Minaret, Tash Hauli Palace, Islam Khodja Minaret and Madrassah, Shirgazi Khan Madrassah, Pahlavan Mahmud Mausoleum. Overnight in hotel.

#### **Day 12. Khiva – Nukus**

Breakfast. Driving to Nukus to the sixth-largest city in Uzbekistan, and the capital of the autonomous Karakalpakstan Republic. The Amu Darya river passes west of the town. The city is best known for its world-class Nukus Museum of Art. Dinner and overnight in hotel.

#### **Day 13. Nukus – Moinag – Nukus**

Drive to former fishermen's village Muynak, which used to be situated on the shores of Aral Sea. Formerly a sea port, now home to only a few thousand residents at most, Moinag's population has been declining precipitously since the 1980s due to the recession of the Aral Sea. The major attractions are the armada of rusting hulks that once made up its fishing fleet during the Soviet era, and a one-room museum devoted to Moinoq's heritage as a center of the fishing industry.

Driving back to Nukus. Overnight in hotel.

#### **Day 14. Nukus – Urgench**

After breakfast driving to Urgench the western city of Uzbekistan. It is the capital of the Khorezm Region, on the Amu Darya River and the Shavat canal. The city is situated 450 km (280 mi) west of Bukhara across the Kyzylkum Desert. Overnight in hotel.

#### **Day 15. Urgench – Bukhara**

Driving to Bukhara.

Overnight in hotel in Bukhara.

**Day 16. Bukhara – Samarkand**

Driving to Samarkand. Resting time. Overnight in hotel.

**Day 17. Samarkand - Tashkent****Day 18. Tashkent**

Breakfast at hotel. Driving to Tashkent the capital of Uzbekistan. Here you can visit Abdul Kasim Madrassah, Khast Imam Complex – a religious center of the city consisting of the Barakkhan Madrasah, Kaffal Shashi Mausoleum and the library of Islamic Literature with the Holy Koran Book of the VII century. Explore traditional Chor-Su Bazaar. Visit modern part of Tashkent: Amir Timur Square, Applied Art Museum, Earthquake Memorial, Independence Square. Overnight in a hotel.

**Day 19. Tashkent – Taraz**

Breakfast. Driving to Taraz the one of the oldest cities in Kazakhstan, known already in the VI century. In ancient, this city was the part of Silk Road. The city located on the Talas (Taraz) River in the south of the country near the border with Kyrgyzstan.

Overnight in a hotel.

**Day 20. Taraz – Bishkek**

Back to Bishkek. Resting time in a hotel.

Farewell dinner.

**Day 21. Leaving**

End the services.
